

Day 3 Monday 27 November 2017

Singapore

This morning we will enjoy a sightseeing tour of Singapore with a local guide. We will drive along Orchard Road, the heart of Singapore's shopping and entertainment district, through the colonial area and the Civic District to view the Supreme Court, the old Cricket Club, the Anglican Church of St Andrews and the Botanic Gardens and the Orchid Garden. Around midday we are transferred to the port to board the magnificent Sapphire Princess.

Day 4 Tuesday 28 November 2017

Kota Permai Golf and Country Club. Kota Permai is a serious golf course with elevation changes, multiple water hazards and lighting fast greens. Always presented in impeccable condition it has hosted numerous tournaments including the Maybank Malaysian Open, sanctioned by both the European and Asian Tours, as well as the World Cup Qualifying round, the Volvo Masters and most recently, the Selangor Worldwide Masters.

Day 5 Wednesday 29 November 2017 Penang, Malaysia

Penang Golf Club. Playing on the Robert Trent Jones Jr designed golf course, golfers can get glimpses of the stunning panoramic view of Penang including the two bridges that link Penang island to the mainland which can be clearly seen from different holes. The course was the venue for the 31st Malaysian Open in 1992 which was won by Vijay Singh.

Day 6 Thursday 30 November 2017 Phuket, Thailand

Red Mountain Golf Club. Winding its way through a truly dramatic former tin mine site in the heart of Phuket, Red Mountain is surely one of Asia's most exciting new courses. The course has been cleverly routed to take advantage of a huge variety of landforms and dizzying elevation changes. Scars left from the tin mine era have been imaginatively incorporated into the overall scheme, creating a unique character at the same time as establishing an indelible link with an important era in the Island's past.

Day 7 Friday 1 December 2017 At sea

A day at sea is the perfect opportunity to explore the fabulous facilities of this magnificent ship.

Day 8 Saturday 2 December 2017 Singapore

Raffles Golf Club. (Lake Course). Raffles Country Club is housed in 146 hectares of land. The Lakes Course weaves its way through spectacular grounds, providing beautiful vistas from every hole. This Robert Trent Jones II masterpiece is renowned for its fast and true greens; a real test for the best of putters.

Day 10 Monday 4 December 2017 Kota Kinabalu, Malaysia

Day 12 Wednesday 6 December 2017 Nha Trang, Vietnam

Vinpearl Golf Nha Trang. Situated on its own picturesque valley along an 800 metres stretch of pristine white sand beach at Vinpearl's destination complex on Hon Tre Island, Nha Trang Bay – named one of Forbes Magazine's 30 most beautiful bays on earth. Designed by renowned IMG Worldwide, this impressive 18-hole, par 71 championship masterpiece was Vietnam's first international standard golf course, offering unique island golfing experiences with blue ocean views.

Day 13 Thursday 7 December 2017 Ho Chi Minh City (Phu My), Vietnam

The Bluffs Ho Tram Strip. Designed to capture the true essence of links-style golf, The Bluffs is routed over and around towering sand dunes, which have been shaped over thousands of years by the elements. The wind plays a major role in the experience here; it's always strong, and its prevailing direction differs depending on the time of year.

Said the course's designer, Greg Norman: "The experience of playing true links golf among the dunes of southern Vietnam and having dramatic ocean views throughout your round will make The Bluffs Ho Tram Strip one of the most unique golf experiences in the world."

Day 14 Friday 8 December 2017 At sea

Day 15 Saturday 9 December 2017 Bangkok (Laem Chabang) Thailand

Laem Chabang International Country Club. Here you will enjoy the feeling of being close to nature in this lush and exotic course designed by famed golfer, Jack Nicklaus. This world-class golf course consists of 27 holes on 700 acres and each hole is different depending on its environment.

Day 16 Sunday 10 December 2017 Ko Samui, Thailand

Santiburi Samui Country Club. This 18-hole championship golf course has been an essential stop on the PGA Asian Tour for many years. The stunning highlands course is set amidst a preserved coconut palm plantation. It is difficult to imagine a more beautiful setting – rolling greens marked by painted coconuts, sunlight streaming through a canopy of palms and views stretching out to Koh Phangan Island.

Touring can involve a considerable amount of walking and stair climbing in the places visited and it is important that all tour participants have a level of physical fitness that allows them to take part in this tour without the need of assistance from others.

Tour Operator: Travelrite International Pty Ltd (ABN 64 005 817 078) is the tour organiser. The Sapphire Princess is operated by Princess Cruises and the golf tour arrangements are subject to the terms and conditions and general information detailed in the Princess Cruises brochure. All passengers must complete the Princess Cruises online check-in on www.princess.com as well as a Travelrite booking form.

Golf Courses and Tee Times: Golf bookings have been made for all the courses and tee times are confirmed.

Maximum Handicaps: Golf courses in Asia require a handicap and you should bring your current handicap certificate with you.

Deposits and Payments: Travelrite International has to pay substantial deposits up-front to secure dates on these elite golf courses as well as to book accommodation in the high quality hotels. You are therefore required to pay a non-refundable deposit of \$800 per passenger, at the time of booking. The final balance is due within 90 days of departure.

General: A 1.5% administration fee will be added to all payments made by Visa and Master Card. 3% administration charge will be added to payments by Amex and Diners Club cards. If fares and air taxes change due to government and airport regulations and currency fluctuations Travelrite reserves the right to charge additional amounts.
